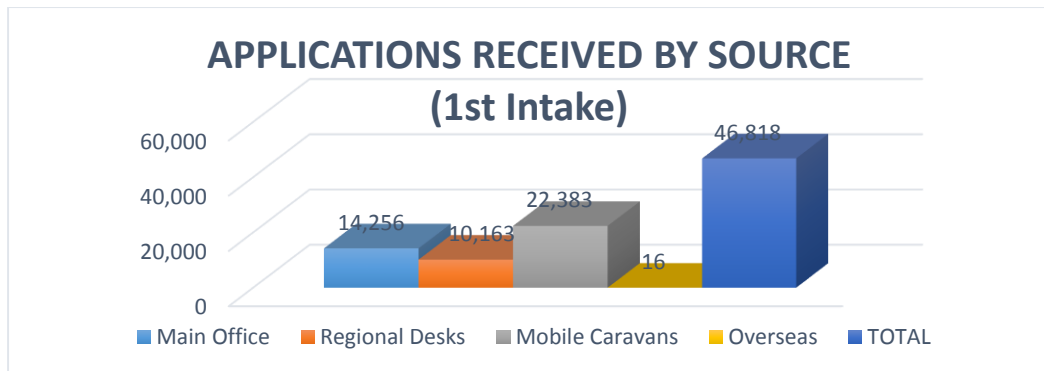


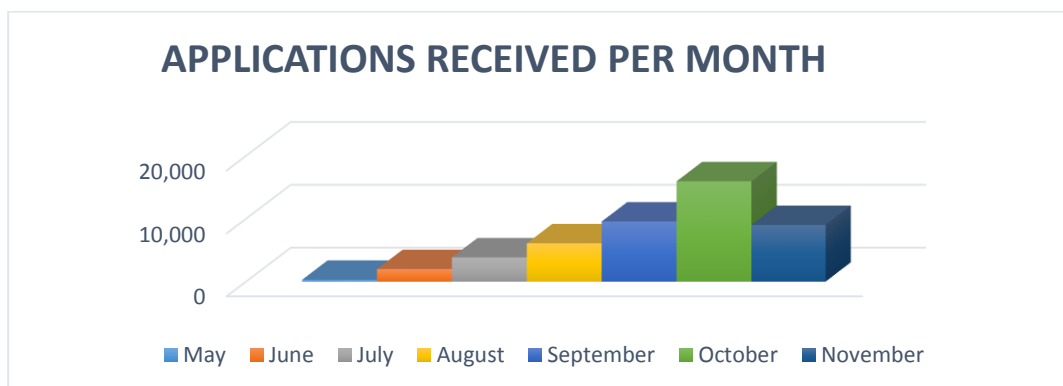
## A. Current Situation

### 1. Intake (Phase 1)

After the conclusion of the six-month intake period last 10 November 2014, the Human Rights Victims' Claims Board (HRVCB) received a total of **46,818** applications for reparation and recognition:



The surge of applicants was experienced during the last three (3) months of intake operations. This is shown by the following graph and average of applicants catered by the office:



*September 2014 = 120 applicants per day*

*October 2014 = 187 applicants per day*

*November 2014 = 390 applicants per day*

### 2. Post-Intake Activities

In November 2014, the Secretariat started evaluating claims for reparation and recognition. The applications and their supporting documents were continuously **updated** in our system database.

In December, the Board, through its three (3) Divisions, resumed adjudicating claims as its Chairperson and Members helped in the intake operations of the Secretariat because of the volume of applications received.

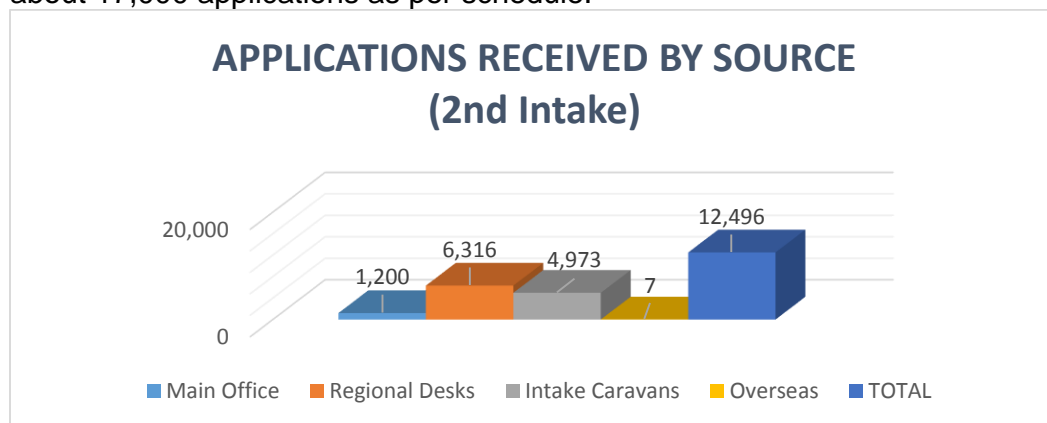
### 3. Passage of Joint Resolution No. 03

On 17 February 2015, President Benigno Aquino III approved **Joint Resolution No. 03** (Tab "A") which extends the period for submission of application for claims under Republic Act No. 10368 up to May 2015. Said

amendment was published in the Official Gazette on 23 March 2015. Pursuant to its mandate, the Board set the commencement and termination of intake operations **from 8 April 2015 to 30 May 2015**, which period was **duly published** in Pilipino Star Ngayon on 26 March 2015 and Philippine Daily Inquirer on 28 March 2015.

**4. Intake (Phase 2)**

After the resumption of intakes last 08 April 2015 the HRVCB received 12,496 applications for recognition and reparation as of 05 May 2015, and is expecting about 17,000 applications as per schedule.
